






































EVENT DETAILS.

- Polar Plunge registration opens at 10AM at the entrance of the Main Tent at Kershaw Park. EVERYONE must register and sign a waiver (U18 must have a parent/guardian signature)!
- Live stage, costume judging, awards & more is from 10AM-12Noon inside the Main Event Tent at Kershaw Park.
- The Canandaigua Polar Plunge kicks off at 12Noon with the National Anthem at 11:55AM inside the Main Event Tent.

PARKING DETAILS.

- The Canandaigua Polar Plunge presented by Nolan's on Canandaigua Lake is taking place at Kershaw Park, 155 Lakeshore Drive, Canandaigua, NY 14424
- All are encouraged to park in the Muar Street Parking Lot (near the Speedway), and there is street parking.
- There will be signage to direct.

WHAT SHOULD I WEAR?

- Have fun! Wear a costume. Be a Superhero. A Princess. A Clown. Be Creative and Get into the Polar Plunge Spirit!
- Dress warm and in layers. It's going to be chilly!
- Wear shoes (water shoes are best). Shoes are a MUST!
- NO flip flops.

WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

- An extra change of clothes, socks, and shoes for after your polar plunge.
- A towel.
- A garbage bag to put your wet clothes in after your polar plunge.
- There are port-a-lets on site to change if needed.
- Money for merchandise and food!
- Please do not bring with your valuables, your favorite sweatshirt. Special Olympics New York is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

WHEN SHOULD I ARRIVE AND WHERE DO I PARK?

- Don't be late! Some of the best parts of the Canandaigua Polar Plunge
 presented by Nolan's on Canandaigua Lake is what happens before the actual
 polar plunge. The pre-Plunge party kicks off at 10AM. Plan to spend the morning
 with us. If you can't, be inside the Main Event Tent by 11:15AM. The
 Canandaigua Polar Plunge presented by Nolan's on Canandaigua Lake starts at
 11:30AM.
- Parking is available at the Muar Street Parking lot and street parking.
- Allow yourself PLENTY of time to park and make your way to Kershaw Park.



WHEN YOU ARRIVE ON SATURDAY... CHECK IN AT THE POLAR PLUNGE REGISTRATION TENT

- Registration opens at 10AM.
- All Plungers must to check in at Registration inside the Polar Plunge tent. It's located at Kershaw Park to the left of Bath House.
- At check in, each polar plunger will sign a participant waiver, receive a wristband to Plunge and polar plungers raising a minimum \$100 will receive the 2024 Polar Plunge crewneck.
- EVERYONE must register and sign a waiver.
- Polar Plungers 18 years and younger must have a parent/guardian signature on waiver.
- If you are bringing donations to the Polar Plunge in the form of cash and/or checks, your donations can be brought directly to the Polar Plunge Registration Tent. Checks should be made payable to "Special Olympics New York"
- If you raised your money all online...don't worry! We will have totals for each polar plunger at registration.
- If you're part of a team you DO NOT need to check in with your team. Each polar plunger can check in at any of the registration lines and meet with their team afterward.
- For teams with team donations, donations can be allocated to team members. Please contact Kelley at kligozio@nyso.org to assist.
- Day of event plungers are welcome. We ask you to donate a minimum of \$25.

WHERE IS THE COSTUME JUDGING CONTEST, TEAM PHOTOS and VENDORS?

- Show your polar plunge spirit by wearing a costume to plunge! We'll have costume voting, awarding First, Second and Third Place, best costumes inside the Main Event Tent at Kershaw Park.
- The costume judging contest is from 10AM-11:30AM judged by Mayor Palumbo.
- Individual and Team photos will also be taken at the Special Olympics backdrop area inside the Main Event Tent at Kershaw Park.

WHERE DO I POLAR PLUNGE AND IS THE WATER ICE COLD?

- The Canandaigua Polar Plunge presented by Nolan's on Canandaigua Lake takes place in the icy waters of Canandaigua Lake directly at Kershaw Park.
- At 11:55AM, the National Anthem will be sung by Josh Sohn and following the National Anthem, polar plungers will begin forming a line inside the Main Event Tent to take the parade into the waters of Canandaigua Lake.
- Yes, you are correct, the water is chilly but hopefully not as chilly as the air!
- Please FOLLOW all polar plunge rules... <u>NO DIVING!</u>
